

Limits for Transfers & Payments

Transfer and payment limits for enhanced security

With digital and self-service banking becoming an integral part of our everyday lives, HSBC maintains high security levels to deliver safe and convenient services. We have daily limits for transfers to registered or non-registered accounts and payments to merchants made through digital and self-service channels, including Online and Mobile Banking, phone banking and ATM services. You can easily manage your transfers and payments limits via the channel of your choice.

Up to HKD3,000,000 limit for local and overseas transfers to registered accounts and HKD400,000 master limit¹ for local and overseas transfers to non-registered accounts

There is a daily limit of up to HKD3,000,000 for local and overseas transfers to each registered account. There is also a daily master limit¹ of up to HKD400,000 per customer for local and overseas transfers to non-registered accounts² through digital and self-service banking. You can set sublimits for each channel to suit your needs. For HSBC Global Transfers³, our free and instant transfer to overseas personal HSBC accounts across the world, there is a daily limit of up to USD200,000 for transfers to your self-named overseas HSBC accounts and up to USD50,000 for transfers to other overseas HSBC accounts.

Up to HKD10,000 small-value payment limit for online transfers

You can pay up to HKD10,000 quickly with FPS QR code or transfer via online or mobile banking without additional security authentication. You can adjust your small-value payment limit anytime via online or mobile banking with your Mobile Security Key (MSK) or Security Device.

Up to HKD5,000,000 master limit for payments to merchants

With the master limit for payments to merchants, you can set sub-limits for each merchant category. Please note that the daily master limit and sub-limits for transfers and payments are applied per customer, regardless of the number of accounts held. For selected merchants⁴, you can pay up to a limit of up to HKD400,000 per day (i.e. the daily master limit¹ for transfers to non-registered accounts as above) via FPS QR code if you have activated your MSK.

Limits reset automatically when usage is inactive

For better account protection, we will reset your sub-limit to 0 for non-registered transfers via Online or Mobile Banking as well as phone banking and your sub-limit to merchant categories of Securities Brokers or Sports & Leisure on all channels if:

- You haven't logged on to that channel for 6 consecutive months.
- You haven't used the service via that channel for 13 consecutive months.

Adjusting transfer and payment limits

With the transaction-signing capability along with MSK and Security Device, you can use Online Banking to:

- Set up registered transfer accounts
- Define or increase transfer limit
- Change master daily limits for transfers and merchant payments
- Change sub-limits for merchant payments to each merchant category

Up to HKD100,000 master limit for local transfers using Top up HSBC accounts via eDDA⁵

You can transfer in funds through online or mobile banking from your same-name accounts at selected local bank(s)⁶ via Top up HSBC accounts via eDDA. You can set a daily transfer limit up to HKD/RMB 10,000 per account top-up instruction. The daily master limit for fund transfers by Top up HSBC accounts via eDDA is HKD100,000 per customer.

Notes:

- 1. The daily master limit for local and overseas transfers to non-registered accounts of HKD400,000 does not include the HKD10,000 of maximum small value payment limit through digital banking.
- 2. For ATM services, we consider any accounts not linked to an ATM card to be non-registered accounts
- 3. HSBC Global Transfers is exclusively available to HSBC Jade, HSBC Premier and HSBC One customers.
