

## **General Promotional Terms and Conditions of TOEFL Test Offer**

- 2. "Eligible Customer" is defined as a customer who has fulfilled all the following requirements:
  - a. not be a citizen/resident/tax payer resident of the United States of America (U.S.); and
  - b. who has successfully opened (or, where applicable, converted an account to) an Integrated Account HSBC Premier (the "Premier Account") with the Bank as the sole accountholder or as the principal accountholder (if a joint account) through any branch of the Bank in Hong Kong, customer service hotline, HSBC HK Mobile Banking app or Online Banking and maintain the Premier Account with the Bank; and
