Important Notes

- 1. Any errors or discrepancies should be reported to the Bank within 90 days of the statement date otherwise this statement shall be considered to be correct. In this respect, please pay attention from time to time to the terms and conditions governing your account.
- 2. The market unit price and market value are for reference only.
- 3. Any currency conversion is based on the currency's prevailing exchange rate as at the close of business on the statement date. This equivalent balance is for reference only.
- 4. For some bonds/notes where a market price is not available, the nominal value will be shown under the Market Value Column.
- 5. The income amount credited is the gross entitlement less the total charges. If the Bank charges exceed the gross entitlement, we will deduct the total of the gross entitlement as the full and final settlement of our charges.
- 6. All dates/times of transactions refer to the time in the relevant market. For example, all dates/times for U.S. Stock trading refer to U.S Eastern Time (ET).
- 7. Trading fee refers to fees relating to the relevant regulatory authority or organisation/exchange. For example:
 - the trading fee collected for HKEx for H.K. stock transactions.
 - the SEC fee collected for U.S. stock sell transactions.

Safe custody fee (applicable to bonds/certificates of deposits/ stocks)

For Personal banking customers, the safe custody fee will be collected monthly or half yearly in June and December of each year. Charges will be collected on or before 20th of the month. For Corporate customers, the safe custody fee will be collected half yearly in June and December of each year. If the collection day falls on the first day of the month and is not a business day, the fee may be collected on the business day which immediately precedes that day, subject to the decision of the Bank.

- I. In compliance with securities dealing restrictions in the United States of America (US) and Canada (CN), customers changing any of their addresses on our record to US or CN will not be able to continue to enjoy our investment services.
 Please also note that personal customers (who are South Korean nationals) changing any of their addresses on our record to South Korea will not be able to continue to enjoy our investment services.
- II. If you are holding with the Bank an overseas securities account and/or treasuries/bonds/bank deposits (including CDs) or any other securities/investments **issued by a United States issuer**, you are required to separately submit to the Bank a new form W-8BEN (Certificate of Foreign status of Beneficial Owner for United States Tax Withholding) or such other form as required by the Bank from time to time incorporating your new address and other updated information.
